Exchange duration: 3 months (September to December)

Application deadline for incoming students: May 15

Choice of elective courses

Fees and cost of living

Students will be responsible for all of their expenses including living expenses, transportation costs, medical insurance and book purchase during their stay at IIM Ranchi. Students need to pay regular tuition fees at the home institute before departure for exchange.

During your stay at IIM Ranchi, major expenses include: Boarding and meals: INR 75,000 (for three months); Text book & Course Materials: INR 15,000.
