

Concludes 5th Batch of Nurturing Future Leadership

IIM, Ranchi concludes 5th batch of nurturing leadership

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IIM, Ranchi successfully concluded the fifth batch of its Nurturing Future Leadership Program, held from September 15 to 19. Conducted under the aegis of the Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP) of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, this five-day residential program saw the participation of 44 educators from across the country.
