

## FAQs for International Applicants

1. What is the SAT Registration Number on the IPM application form and SAT ID on IPM Application fee link?

Answer: Please use the "Record Locator" on the SAT score card in place of the SAT Registration Number on the application form and SAT ID on Application fee link.

2. What if I do not have a College Board Student ID on the SAT Score Card?

Answer: In that case, please use your "Record Locator" on the SAT score card also in place of College Board Student Id.

3. What is the SII Application No. in the Application Form?

Answer: When you apply on the SII Portal, you will get a Student ID. You have to fill it on the Application Form at the IIM Ranchi website.

4. What is the sequence of filling in the application form for foreign students?

Answer:

Step 1:

Ensure that you fulfill all the necessary conditions for application by visiting <https://iimranchi.ac.in/admissions/>

Step 2:

Fill in the application on the Study in India Portal (<https://www.studyinindia.gov.in/>) for the appropriate course.

Step 3:

Pay the application fee on the appropriate payment link for the course you seek to apply at <https://iimranchi.ac.in/admissions/>

Step 4:

Fill in the application form for the specific course at <https://iimranchi.ac.in/admissions/>

6. Is it necessary to have a Non-Indian Passport to apply for seats earmarked for foreign students?

Answer: Yes. If you are an Indian citizen, you cannot apply for seats earmarked for foreign students. You can apply through the separate application process for Indian citizens as is already available.

7. I am in Indian citizen but I have a foreign Residence Card/Permanent Residence Card/Long Term Visa/Green Card, can I apply for seats earmarked for foreign students?

Answer: No. You can apply through the separate application process for Indian citizens as is already available.

8. What is the fee payable by foreign students for MBA/MBA-HRM/MBA-BA/IPM against seats earmarked for foreign students?

Answer: As of now, the fee structure is same for Indian and foreign students. However, foreign students, if selected, will have to bear the cost of visa/residence permit, travel, official permissions, and suitable health insurance themselves.
