Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Category: Admissions and Withdrawal Queries

Question. Where can I know the status of my offer from IIM Ranchi? Also, how have the scores and ranks been calculated?

Answer: Admission Offers and waitlist positions are available on the Admission Portal accessible through the link available at <https://iimranchi.ac.in/admissions/> . We recommend you to check it regularly to know about the status of your offer or waitlist position. The Admission Criteria used for calculating the scores and ranks is available [here](#).

Question. If I have received an offer, how can I accept it?

Answer: If you have received an offer, you can accept it by making the payment of the fee for the First Term through the admission portal within the deadline provided, and a receipt will be generated in case of a successful transaction.

Question. Is there any possibility to make a part payment to accept an admission offer?

Answer: There is no possibility of part payment and the fee for the First Term has to be paid on the admission portal within the deadline provided.

Question. I do not have a valid NC-OBC/EWS/ST/SC/DAP certificate and/or UDID Card. Will I be allowed to physically register during the registration process at IIM Ranchi?

Answer: Unfortunately, in such a situation registration at IIM Ranchi will not be possible and the offer will stand withdrawn.

Question. If I am unable to join on the start date due to my notice period, will I be allowed to join later? If yes, what is the procedure?

Answer: We do not allow late joining as this may lead to attendance shortage.

Question: If I decide to withdraw from the program on or before notified date of commencement of classes, what amount will be refunded? How long will the refund process take?

Answer: Refund will be governed by the Withdrawal Policy which is available [here](#)

Question: Can I withdraw from the MBA-HRM/MBA-BA programme after accepting the offer and shift to the core MBA program (and vice versa) if I get selected from the waitlist? If so, how would my fees be adjusted?

Answer: Yes, if you convert the waitlist, you will be shifted to MBA, based on your request through the portal and the fee will be adjusted for MBA Programme as per the Withdrawal Policy available [here](#). Please refer specially to Sl. No. (g) and (h) of the Withdrawal Policy on the exact terms and possibility for adjustment of fee.

Question: Does the total fee of Rs. 19.20 lakhs include hostel and mess charges, or are they separate? If separate, what are the additional charges?

Answer: It includes hostel charges but mess fee needs to be paid separately. Please refer to fee structure available [here](#)

Question: I have an EWS/NC-OBC certificate for FY 2025-2026. Can I use it for my admission process, or do I need a new one for FY 2025-2026?

Answer: You need to submit a new one valid for FY 2026-2027

Question: I have received an offer for both MBA and MBA-BA programmes at IIM Ranchi. Can I pay the fee and retain my seat for both the programmes at the same time.

Answer: A candidate can remain registered and accept the offer for one programme out of MBA/MBA-BA/MBA-HRM only. Let's say a candidate had received an offer for MBA-BA in the first round and was waitlisted for MBA, and he chose to accept the offer for MBA-BA after payment of the fee. Now, let's say that his waitlist position got changed and he received an offer for MBA after 15 days. In that case, the candidate may shift to MBA by accepting the offer through the portal and his position in MBA-BA will get released and may be offered to the next eligible candidate. The candidate in such a case will be considered to have withdrawn from MBA-BA and will not be eligible to claim the seat later on in that programme.

Category: Fee Related Queries

Question: What is the exact due date for submitting the term 1 fees? Is there any flexibility in the deadline, especially if I am waiting for education loan approval?

Answer: There is no possibility of part payment and the fee for the First Term has to be paid on the admission portal within the deadline provided. If you have received an offer or are on the waitlist and expecting an offer from IIM Ranchi, we encourage you to make necessary arrangements for education loan accordingly so as to be able to make the fee payment within the deadline.

Question: If there are any issues with the payment (e.g., transaction failure or rejection), what is the process for resolving these issues and ensuring my admission status is not affected?

Answer: Admission will be confirmed only upon receipt of payment by the Admissions Office. To resolve such issues, get in touch with the admission office immediately at office.admissions@iimranchi.ac.in. Escalation can be made to chair.admissions@iimranchi.ac.in if a response is not received within 48 hours.

Question: Will my fee deposited be returned if I fail to produce correct documents/information during the physical registration process for admission at IIM Ranchi?

Answer: In such a case, refund may be provided if the physical registration process for the candidate happens on or before the notified date of commencement of classes.

Question: Can you provide detailed information on the available scholarships and financial aid options for students, including eligibility criteria and the application process?

Answer: IIM Ranchi facilitates multiple scholarships to support and encourage meritorious and deserving students enrolled in its MBA/MBA-BA/MBA-HRM programs. These scholarships are broadly categorized as **Government-Funded Scholarships** and **Institute-Facilitated Scholarships**.

Additional Notes:

- Students need to maintain a minimum **CGPA** as defined under each scholarship.
- Timely application with supporting documents is crucial.
- Some scholarships may require submission of income certificates, caste certificates, and domicile proof.

Category: Curriculum Course Academic Calendar

Question: Could you please confirm the exact start date of the program for the [MBA/MBA-HR] batch 2026-27? I would also like to know the overall duration of the program and any significant milestones such as mid-term breaks or major holidays.

Answer: The tentative dates are as following:

Physical Registration: 12-14th June 2026

Commencement of Classes: 15th June 2026

The above dates may be subject to change and the actual date of commencement of classes will be notified on the website. If there are any changes in the dates, it will be communicated in due course of time.

There are no major holidays; however, term breaks are provided at the end of each term, with the duration varying accordingly and it will be communicated by the APO office and may be subject to change.

Question: Can you provide the dates for vacations, national holidays, and any planned breaks throughout the course? I need this information to plan accordingly for personal and professional commitments.

Answer: At the beginning of each term, you will be informed about the national holidays applicable for that particular term.

Question: What is the general examination schedule, and when are the mid-term and final exams typically held? Are there any specific academic sessions or workshops that I should be aware of?

Answer: The college follows a trimester system. Exams are conducted every 5–6 weeks as end-terms for each term. There are no specific academic sessions. All other details will be explained at the start of the term. It must however be noted that the Institute places high emphasis on Academic Performance and Rigor, and candidates securing below CGPA 5 at the end of the first year may not be considered for certain placement processes.

Question: In case I am unable to join the campus on the exact start date due to prior commitments or notice period at my current job, would I be allowed to join the program at a later date? If yes, what would be the procedure for late arrival and making up for any missed sessions?

Answer: No, Students are required to join the programme from the date of commencement of the course, otherwise it will lead to attendance shortage.

Admission Registration, Final Year Marks Sheet & Degree Related

Question: I will be completing my graduation by June 14th 2026. Can I join the program and submit my final year mark sheet later if my degree certificate has not been issued yet? Would a provisional degree certificate be acceptable for admission and document verification purposes?

Answer: You can join the programmes, however your admission will be completely provisional and you would be required to submit the final mark sheet & degree by 30 September 2026.

Question: I have received my provisional degree certificate, but my original degree certificate is still in the process of being issued by my university. Is it necessary to submit the original degree certificate at the time of admission, or is the provisional certificate sufficient until the original is available?

Answer: You can join the programmes, however your admission will be completely provisional and you would be required to submit the final mark sheet & degree by 30 September 2026 and your admission will be totally provisional subject to the submission of the missing documents.

Question: When will the document verification process take place, and what documents will I need to submit during the verification? Is there any flexibility in submitting the final mark sheet if it is not available by the verification date?

Answer: The list of documents required will be intimated to you by the Academic Programme Office and Information will also be provided on the IIM Ranchi website at <https://iimranchi.ac.in/admissions/>. If any academic documents are not available, you would be required to submit such missing document by 30 September 2026 and in such cases your admission will be completely provisional.

Question: The information/documents submitted during CAT application and JAP process do not match the documents that I have produced at the time of physical registration for admission at IIM Ranchi. Can I update the information now?

Answer: In such a case, the offer made by IIM Ranchi stands withdrawn and you will not be admitted to IIM Ranchi.

Question: Is the Campus far from the city? How can we commute?

Answer: The Campus is located around 12 km from Ranchi Airport and Ranchi Railway Station. It is around 10 km from Hatia Railway Station. Ola/Uber/Rapido and other app based taxi/auto services are easily available at the Campus and from any part of Ranchi to the Campus. The Institute also operates a Shuttle Bus with service till 9 pm. Question: I have an EWS/NC-OBC certificate issued for FY 2025-2026, but I no longer fall under this category for FY 2026-2027. Can I still submit the old certificate for my admission, or do I need to provide a new one?

Answer: You need to submit a new one valid for FY 2026-2027.

Question: As a married student, I would like to know if married student accommodation is available on campus. If so, what are the additional charges, and how can I apply for this?

Answer: As on today we do not have any provision for married couple accommodation.

Question: I have faced repeated payment failures while trying to pay the acceptance fee. Could you assist with resolving this issue? Also, in case of any payment failure, will the fees be refunded automatically or do I need to request a refund?

Answer: Please check directly with your bank for any updates or issues. However, in all such cases please inform the same to the Admission Office through email.

Question: I have a provisional degree certificate but not the original degree certificate. Will the provisional certificate be accepted during the document verification process, or do I need to submit the original certificate?

Answer: Yes, it may be accepted, however you will be required to produce the original certificate by 30 September, 2026. Also, in such case your admission will be totally provisional.

Question: I have paid the acceptance fee but haven't received any communication about the next steps. Could you please confirm when I will receive further details regarding the registration?

Answer: You will be intimated about the next steps such as notified date for registration and commencement of classes through an announcement on IIM Ranchi website.

Question: I have questions specifically regarding accommodation and hostel. Whom should I connect?

Question: I am a student with a disability (DAP category) and would like to know what accommodations are available to support my needs during the program. Is there any special assistance provided for students with disabilities?
