The para wise reply of the above mentioned Parliament Questions: -

Q. No. (a) The details of new IITs, IIMs, AIIMS, Central Universities and Technical Institutes which have been established in the country during the last ten years and the current year?

Reply: IIM Ranchi was established in 2009

Q. No. (b) The State-wise distribution of the establishment of these institutions?

Reply: IIM Ranchi is located in Jharkhand.

Q. No. (c) The details of budgetary allocation for Higher Education Infrastructure Development in the Union Budget 2025-26 and its comparison with the actual expenditure of previous years?

Reply: No financial grant has been received during the financial year 2024-2025 from the Ministry of Education, Government of India. Further, no sanction letter relating to the grant has also not been received.

Q. No. (d) The measures taken to address the faculty shortage and research funding constraints in newly established and existing IITs and IIMs?

Reply: At present, there is no shortage of faculty in IIM Ranchi. In the past, when there was any shortage of faculty, we advertised the post for the area requirement on the website, and filled up the vacancies.

There is no Constraints in research funding at IIM Ranchi.

Q. No. (e) The details of incentives provided to attract international faculty?

Reply: The IIM Ranchi, the international visiting faculty member will be paid INR equivalent of a sum between USD 1500 to USD 2500 per month (exclusive of any mandatory statutory payments), based on experience and qualifications. The faculty member will be liable to pay for and tax contribution for the payment received. Travel Health Insurance, concessional accommodation and food facilities at IIM Ranchi Campus during the term of his/her stay will be provided. Round-trip airfare from the nearest airport of the current place of residence to IIM Ranchi (to be booked by IIM Ranchi).

Q. No. (f) The details of policies which promote the Multi-disciplinary Research, Startup Incubation Centres, and AI-Based Learning Modules in Premier Institutions?

Reply: The faculty from the different areas of management come together to work on a single

project. The research project is undertaken by different lenses of management, which reflects multi-disciplinary research behaviour.

IIM Ranchi incorporated AI policy in the course outline of the MBA courses. The faculty uses AI-based tools to make their classroom engaging.

Q.No. (g) Whether the Government plans to bridge the gap between public and private Higher Education Institutions and ensure equal access to world-class education for students from economically weaker sections?

Reply: The Institute supports EWS students by providing scholarships, category reservation and internal merit-based schemes.

IIM Ranchi has started a five year Integrated Programme in Management (IPM) in the year 2021.

Number of seats is – 60

Fee for the first three year is ₹17.25 lakh (excluding Caution Deposit, Alumni Fee & Mess Expense). The fee for the last two years will be the same as the MBA fees for those particular years.

a. Mode of Selection- IPMAT Score (Conducted by IIM Indore) + Personal Interview

b. Criteria: Candidates should have passed the 10th standard and the 12th standard (or equivalent) with 60% (55% for candidates from SC/ST/PwD) or more marks. The percentage of marks obtained would be calculated based on the Educational Board's regulations. In cases where there is no such regulation regarding aggregate marks from the concerned Educational

Board, the aggregate marks of all the subjects that appear in the grade sheet will be considered for calculating the final percentage. IIM Ranchi accepts only the scores of IPMAT (conducted by IIM Indore). The Institute reserves the right to change/modify the admission process/criteria.
