Research Methodology Session 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Measurement and Scaling - Questionnaire Design - Sampling - Data Preparation - Brief of Various Data Analysis Techniques - Report writing - <p>This session describes the implementation part of the research plan. Participants would come to know about the use of scale; developing questionnaire, widely used sampling methods; understanding data; brief about the data analysis techniques; and finally how to write a research report.</p>
Loan Waivers and Farm Subsidies	<p>The objective of the session is to consider the government’s policy on the agricultural loan waivers and farm subsidies in India, and assess the same from an economic and legal viewpoint.</p> <p>The session would help the participants understand the problems that are faced by the agricultural sector in India. During periods of high levels of farm distress, there are demands for relief by farmers and their supporters. One of the ways in which the Government provides relief is through waivers of agricultural loans. Another is to provide subsidies to make the prices of agricultural inputs cheaper. The interactive session would allow the participants to assess the advantages and disadvantages of both these</p>



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	means, and understand what more can be done to alleviate problems of farmers in India from a policy-making perspective.
