Advertisement for the Post of Junior Research Fellow (On Contract)

Applications are invited from Indian nationals for the post of **Junior Research Fellow (on contract)** in the research project entitled **“Aadhar for Niraadhar: Bringing the Urban Homeless Poor under the Ambit of Aadhaar”** supported by a grant from Omidyar Network and with Indian School of Business (ISB), Hyderabad as sub-grantor. Essential Qualification: PG in Sociology/Economics/Social Sciences/MBA

Desirable Qualification and Experience: PhD in Sociology/Economics/Social Sciences/Management, with a minimum of one-year research experience in a related area, along with relevant publications. Good academic records along with exposure to statistical tools and software like SPSS would be an added advantage.

Role: The Research Fellow shall help the Principal Investigator in reviewing relevant literature, developing the survey tool, monitoring investigators during survey, collecting and analyzing data, and writing reports.

Fellowship: ₹ 36,000/ per month (Consolidated) + HRA (as per UGC norms)

Other Facilities: Accommodation may be available at the Institute hostel as per availability and Institute norms. Facilities of yearly leave, medical benefits, etc. may be available as per applicable rules of project staff of IIM Ranchi.

Age Limit: 28 years on the last date of application (the upper age limit shall be relaxed up to 5 years in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PH and women candidates).

Tenure of Appointment: Appointment will be made on contract basis for a period of one year only. The selected candidate shall be stationed at Ranchi for the entire duration of the project but has to travel for survey work. The contract can be terminated by either party with a notice of one month.




Note
